Class Schedule and Description :

Reading Readiness (English)

Monday and Wednesday 1:30 pm- 2:15 pm

Due to the small size of the class, the teacher will work individually with each student at his or her level of readiness, and also according to a child's particular learning style. Children's participation and contributions to the class will also be an important part of the class format, as children focus and attend for a longer period of time when their own ideas, responses, and creativity are part of the class material. Classes will incorporate the Montessori philosophy of the joy of discovering reading. This is the beginning of a wonderful journey with words!

The content will include, but not limited to, the following areas of emergent reading, early reading and writing:

- Name recognition and name writing
- Phonemic awareness
- Letter recognition of lower and uppercase letters
- Letter and sound correspondence
- Letter writing
- Word building
- Vocabulary expansion
- Sentence structure
- Story creation and illustration
- Story reading with an emphasis on critical listening and recall.

Weekly themes will be consistent with the in-classroom themes. Materials may vary according to theme and lesson, but will include Montessori materials and other sources.

Everyday Math (English)

Tuesday and Thursday 1:30 pm- 2:15 pm

Everyday Math will use the Singapore Math materials and incorporate Montessori philosophy of „mathematical mind“. These will enable children to use number recognition in a variety of applications, which will become more challenging as the year progresses. The class will utilize a hands-on approach in order to fully engage the children's attention throughout the session.

The program will include the following:

- Numeral Recognition
- Quantity and Symbol
- Sequencing
- Patterning
- Sets
- Simple Addition
- Simple Subtraction
- Fractions
- Telling Time

The program will follow the in-classroom themes as much as possible. Materials may vary according to theme and lesson, but will include Montessori materials and other sources.
